#### **Visa & Enter Requirements**

Most of the visitors from the Americas does not need visa to enter Nicaragua. Upon arrival in Managua, visitors will be required to pay a US \$10 tourism card in cash at Immigration. Due to the **Yellow Fever** outbreak in South America, if you are coming from South America to Nicaragua, you need proof of the Yellow Fever vaccine. ## Climate

Nicaragua has an average temperature of 27°C (80°F) year round. Humidity averages 65% and generally you always feel a little bit 'sticky'. A tropical climate can be observed in Nicaragua. The green season is from mid-May to mid-November, the dry season from late-November to early-May. Rain during the green season is normally limited to short and powerful bursts where you can get absolutely drenched, with longer showers at night.
